THE REGULATION of the 11th World Championship in Fire and Rescue Sport «Saint-Petersburg-2015»

1. Goals and objectives of the competitions

XI World Championship in Fire and Rescue Sport (further – Competitions) is aimed at:

- further development and popularization of the profession of firefighters and rescuers;
- improvement of professional and sportsmanship of workers in fire and rescue services;
- strengthening friendly relations and cooperation between fire and rescue services in different countries;
- popularization and development of the fire and rescue sport among women teams and their participation in the international competitions.

2. Organization of the competitions

The International Sport Federation of Firefighters and Rescuers in cooperation with the Ministry of the Russian Federation for Civil Defense, Emergencies and Elimination of Consequences of Natural Disasters performs general management and organization of the competitions.

The Main Department of the Ministry of Emergency Situations of the Russian Federation in St. Petersburg, the Central Sports Club of EMERCOM of the Russian Federation, Committee on Physical Culture and Sport of St. Petersburg, the Committee on Law, Order and Security of St. Petersburg with the support of the Government of St. Petersburg, the All Russian Public Organization "the Federation of Fire-Applied Sport of Russia", the Regional Public Organization "the Federation of Fire and Rescue Sport of St. Petersburg" carry out the direct organization and holding of the competitions (preparation of the competition places, transfer of the participants from the airport to the hotel and back, medical service, provision of the sports and technical equipment, catering services and accommodation, cultural program, publicity in the mass media, etc.).

The competitions are held in accordance with the rules of the competitions on Fire and Rescue Sport and the Regulations of the international competitions on Fire and Rescue Sport of 2015, approved by the XV International Conference of the International Sport Federation of Firefighters and Rescuers.

The fire and technical equipment (with photo), which apply in combat deployment and fire relay race, should be published on the website www.interfiresport.com no later than **August 5, 2015**.

The competitions are held in the combat deployment of the motor pumps of the company «ROSENBAUER FOX III» with connecting hoses STORZ.

3. Timelines and venue of the competitions

The competitions will take place **from 5 to 10 September 2015**.

The venue of the competitions: **St. Petersburg (the Russian Federation)**.

4. Participants and conditions of admission

The national teams of the member-countries of the International Sport Federation of Firefighters and Rescuers, as well as countries received an invitation, take part in the competitions.

The composition of sports delegations, 31 persons: head of delegation – 1, representative of team – 1, coach – 4, doctor – 1, referee – 2, press – 2, athletes: men – 10, women – 10.

It is allowed to change the quantitative structure of delegation taking into account the declared women and the sports personnel.

The representatives of teams need to submit to credentials committee the signed request and passport (or identity card). The athletes for competitions are not allowed without these documents. The request should be separate for men and women.

The doping control is carried out during the competition. The control is carried out in accordance with the provisions of the World Anti-Doping Codex (WADC), International testing standards and Prohibited list. The order of collecting samples and quantity of samples is determined at the joint meeting of team's representatives and the Main referee panel on **September 6, 2015**.

5. Program of the competition

- 5 September** – Arrival of teams
- 6 September** – Credentials committee
– Meeting of team representatives and the Main Jury
– Competition draw
– Testing of sports equipment
- 7 September** – Climbing on an assault ladder
– Opening ceremony
– Semi-finals and finals of assault ladder
– Rewarding
- 8 September** – Overcoming the 100-meter obstacle
– Semi-finals and finals in overcoming the 100-meter obstacle
– Fire relay race 4x100 meters
- 9 September** – Combat deployment
– Closing ceremony
– Rewarding*
- 10 September** – Departure of teams

** The awarding ceremony of winners by species can be carried out during of the competitions or on the closing day of the competition.*

6. Line-up team and off-set on sports disciplines

Competitions in climbing on an assault ladder, overcoming the 100-meter obstacle, combat deployment carried out on two attempts.

7. Procedure and conditions of defining the team and individual championships

Overall team ranking is determined on the basis of least total placings, taken by teams in all the sports events. In case of equality in total placings, the higher place is awarded to the team having best result in fire attack deployment.

Team championship in youth sport events is determined on the basis of minimum total time, clocked by ranking competitors. In case of equality, the teams are awarded the same place (subsequent rank is not awarded). The team, which has not scored total number of scores, is ranked below the teams having full score. In case of equality of incomplete scores, the team is ranked as per the minimum time of ranking competitors.

Individual championship in sports events, and also ranking in fire attack deployment, is determined as per the best result from two attempts. In case of equality – as per the best total time of two attempts, and in case of level time from two attempts – as per the best result of first attempt, further – who started earlier.

In case of equality results in fire relay race 4x100 meters the higher place is awarded to the team, which started earlier.

Double event is not included in team result.

Finals and semifinals for men and finals for women are held in 4x100 meters firefighter relay race and assault ladder to determine winners. The amount of athletes in final and semifinal races is determined by the number of racetracks. The results of final and semifinal races are not included in team result.

Semifinal races are formed by the results of preliminary races as follows: 1st semifinal race – 5, 1, 4 and 8 results; 2nd semifinal race – 6, 2, 3 and 7. Final race is formed by the results of semifinal races as follows: 3, 1, 2 and 4.

Team and individual championship among men and women in sports disciplines performed separately.

8. Awarding

The teams, which occupy 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places, are awarded with cups and certificates; and participants – with medals and gifts.

The teams, which occupy 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places in fire relay race in 4x100 meters and combat deployment, are awarded with cups and certificates; and participants – with medals, certificates and gifts.

The participants, who occupy 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places in individual championship in climbing on an assault ladder, overcoming 100-meter obstacle course and double-event, are awarded with medals, certificates and gifts.

Winners in sports events are awarded with champion ribbons.

The Coaches of the national teams in all the sports disciplines are awarded with medals, certificates and gifts.

9. Participation conditions of the sports delegations and participants of the competitions

The annual membership fee of \$3300 (three thousand and three hundred US dollars) is transferred to the International Sport Federation of Firefighters and Rescuers before **April 1, 2015**.

The participation fee of \$150 (one hundred and fifty US dollars) for one member of the sports delegation is transferred to the account of the host country **before the competition**.

The expenses, related with business trip of the sports delegations (travel tickets, accommodation, food, daily allowances during travel, salary preservation, etc.), are to be borne by the countries, sending delegation to the /competitions.

Expenses related to organization and conduction of competitions are the responsibility of organizers of competitions at the expense of own and involved means in accordance with the legislation.

10. Procedure and timelines for submission

Preliminary application (official letter) on the participation and quantitative composition of sports delegation should be sent **before July 7, 2015**.

Application for participation of team in competitions in sports disciplines must be provided to the credentials committee on the day of drawing of lots **6 September 2015** (Application 1).

Registration form of a standard form is sent **20 days before the competitions** (Application 2).

This information will be used by the organizer for a meeting / departure, reservations and hotel accommodation, training accreditation badges and other issues.
