REGULATION
of the XV World Championship among boys and juniors and
the XI World Championship among girls and juniors
in fire and rescue sport
«Zhukovsky-2026»

1. Goals and objectives of the competitions

The XV World Championship among boys and juniors and the XI World Championship among girls and juniors in fire and rescue sport (hereinafter referred to as competitions) are aimed at:

- further international cooperation, development of fire and rescue sport and popularization of the profession of firefighter and rescuer among children and youth;
- attracting young men and women to engage in fire and rescue sport and participate in international competitions;
- forming an active life position, professional orientation of the younger generation, preservation and strengthening of the health of children, adolescents and youth;
- improving sports skills and physical education of young firefighters and rescuers;
- strengthening friendly ties and exchange of experience in the training of young athletes;
- preparation of a sports reserve for national sports teams.

2. Organization of competitions

The general management and organization of the competition is carried out by the International Sport Federation of Firefighters and Rescuers in cooperation with the Ministry of the Russian Federation for Civil Defence, Emergencies and Elimination of Consequences of Natural Disasters (EMERCOM), the All-Russian Public Organization "All-Russian Voluntary Fire Organization", the All-Russian Public Organization "Federation of Fire and Rescue Sport of Russia" and the Government of the Moscow Region.

The direct organization and conduct of competitions (preparation of competition venues, transfer of the participants from the airport to the hotel and back, medical care, provision of sports and technical equipment, catering and accommodation, cultural and leisure program, media coverage, etc.) is carried out by the Russian EMERCOM Main Office for the Moscow Region, together with the Federal State Institution "Physical Training and Sports Center of the EMERCOM of Russia", the Ministry of Sports of the Moscow Region, the All-Russian Public Organization "All-Russian Voluntary Fire Organization", the All-Russian Public Organization "Federation of Fire and Rescue Sports of Russia" and the Moscow Region Office of the Federation of Fire and Rescue Sports of Russia.

The competitions are held in accordance with the International Rules of Competitions in Fire and Rescue Sport and the Regulations of International Competitions in Fire and Rescue Sport, as amended and modified in 2026.

The firefighting and technical equipment (with photo), which is used in combat deployment and fire relay race, should be published on the website www.interfiresport.com no later than **July 20, 2026**.

The competitions in combat deployment are held with the use of the motor pumps of the company "ROSENBAUER FOX 3" with STORZ connecting hoses.

3. Dates and venue of the competition

Competitions are held: **from August 20 to August 26, 2026**.

Venue: **Russian Federation, Moscow Region (Zhukovsky)**.

4. Competitors and admission conditions

The competitions are attended by the national teams of boys and girls of the member countries of the International Sport Federation of Firefighters and Rescuers, as well as teams of other countries upon invitation.

The composition of the sports delegation – 31 people, of which: the head of the delegation – 1; team representative – 2; coach (boys, girls) – 2, coach-educator (boys, girls) – 2; doctor – 1, judge - 2, press – 2; interpreter – 1;

male athletes – 9 people: born in 2008-2009 – 3 (male juniors), born in 2010-2011 – 3 (middle group), born in 2012 and younger – 3 (younger group);

female athletes – 9 people: born in 2008-2009 – 3 (female juniors), born in 2010-2011 – 3 (middle group), born in 2012 and younger – 3 (younger group);

It is allowed to change the quantitative structure of delegation taking into account the declared athletes and the sports personnel.

The President of the national federation of the country participating in the competition has the right to change the composition of the delegation at his discretion.

The representatives of teams need to submit the signed application and passport (or identity card) to credentials committee. Athletes are not allowed to compete without these documents. Applications are submitted separately for the boys' team and the girls' team.

Doping control is carried out during the competition in accordance with the current provisions of the World Anti-Doping Code (WADA), the International Standard for Testing and the Prohibited List. The procedure and number of samples taken from athletes is determined at a joint meeting of representatives of the teams and the Main Judging Panel on **August 21, 2026**.

5. Competition program

 - Testing of sports equipment
- August 22** – Hook ladder climbing
 - Grand opening ceremony
 - Finals in hook ladder climbing
 - Awarding of winners and prize-winners
- August 23** – 100-meter obstacle course
 - Finals in 100-meter obstacle course
- August 24** – Fire relay 4x100 meters
- August 25** – Combat deployment
 - Closing ceremony
 - Awarding of winners and prize-winners
- August 26** – Departure of teams

** Awarding of winners and prize-winners in different disciplines can be held daily on the days of the competition or on the day of the closing ceremony.*

6. The system of scoring and evaluation in sports disciplines

Competitions in hook ladder climbing, overcoming 100-meter obstacle course and combat deployment are held in two attempts.

7. Procedure and conditions for defining the team and individual championship

The all-team championship for boys and girls is determined by the lowest total of places occupied by the teams in 4 sports disciplines: hook ladder climbing, overcoming 100-meter obstacle course, fire relay race 4x100 meters, combat deployment. In case of equality of the total of places, the higher place is awarded to the team that has the best result in combat deployment.

The team championship in the sports disciplines “Hook ladder climbing” and “Overcoming the 100-meter obstacle course” for boys and male juniors, girls and female juniors is determined by the lowest total of places achieved by the teams in each age group. In case of equality of the total of places, the team championship is determined by the lowest total time achieved by the scoring participants in the sports discipline in all the three age groups.

The championship in the age group is determined by the lowest total time achieved by the scoring participants. In case of equality of total time, the age group is awarded the same place (the subsequent place is not awarded). If there is incomplete scoring in one of the age groups, this age group takes the place after the age groups that have a full set of scores.

The individual championship in the sports disciplines, as well as the championship in the fire relay race and combat deployment for boys and girls, is determined by the best result of one of the two attempts. In case of equal results: by the best total time of two attempts; in case of equality of the total time of two attempts: by the best result of the first attempt; further: who started earlier.

To determine the winners and prize-winners in hook ladder climbing and overcoming the 100-meter obstacle course, final races are held in each age group. The number of athletes in the final races is determined by the number of running tracks. The results of the final races are not included in the team standings. The final races are formed according to the places occupied by the athletes in the preliminary races according to the following scheme: 3rd, 1st, 2nd, 4th place, which corresponds to 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th tracks in the final.

The team and individual championships among boys and girls in sports disciplines are held separately.

8. Awarding

The teams that took the 1st, 2nd, 3rd all-team place are awarded with cups and diplomas; participants – with medals and gifts.

Teams that took 1st, 2nd, 3rd place in the fire relay and combat deployment are awarded with cups and diplomas; participants – with medals, diplomas and gifts.

The participants who took 1st, 2nd, 3rd place in the individual championship in hook ladder climbing, 100-meter obstacle course are awarded with medals, diplomas and gifts.

Winners in sports disciplines are awarded with champion ribbons.

Coaches of national teams in all sports disciplines are awarded with medals, diplomas and gifts.

In the event of an anti-doping rule violation identified during in-competition testing, the athlete's results are automatically disqualified. The results of the remaining athletes are reviewed in accordance with the provisions of the WADA Code.

Competition organizers will amend the final Competition results. Medals, cups, and prizes are subject to return to the athletes (teams) after the changes are made to the final Competition protocols.

9. Participation conditions of the sports delegations

The annual membership fee of 4,000 (three thousand three hundred) US dollars is transferred to the International Sport Federation of Firefighters and Rescuers **before April 1, 2026**.

The participation fee in the amount of 490 (four hundred ninety) USD for one member of the sports delegation is transferred to the account of the host country **before August 20, 2026 or on the day of arrival to the competition**.

The expenses related to the business trip of sports delegations (travel tickets, accommodation, meals, daily allowances during travel, salary preservation, etc.) are borne by the countries sending the delegation to the competition.

The costs of the competitions are borne by the organizers of the competitions at the expense of their own and attracted funds in accordance with the procedure established by law.

The team which failed to pay the membership fee to ISFFR shall not be allowed to take part in competition (Clause 2 of the Standing Order).

10. Procedure and deadlines for submitting applications

The preliminary application (official letter) on the participation and the quantitative composition of the sports delegation shall be sent **before June 20, 2026**.

The application for the team's participation in competitions in sports disciplines shall be submitted to the credentials committee on the day of the draw **August 21, 2026**.

The registration form of the established sample shall be sent **before July 20, 2026**.

This information will be used by the organizers of the event for meeting, organizing the departure, booking hotel rooms, preparation of accreditation badges and solving other organizational issues.
