





REGULATION on Associate Membership

Associate membership in the International Association "International Sport Federation of Firefighters and Rescuers" (hereinafter referred to as the Association) applies to legal entities and persons who recognize the Charter (Statute) of the Association and the principles of its activities, and who have declared their intention actively participate in events to popularize and develop fire and rescue sport. The rights and obligations of Associate Members of the Association are defined by this Regulation.

1. To join the Association as an Associate Member, a candidate's application shall be submitted to the Executive Directorate. The application must contain recognition of the provisions of the Charter (Statute) and other internal documents of the Association and the willingness to comply with them.

2. The said application must be considered at the next Conference of the Association's Members. The decision to admit new members to the Association is made by the Conference of the Association's Members. Preliminary review of documents for the admission of new Associate Members to the Association is carried out by the Executive Directorate of the Association.

3. Associate Members may elect and be elected to the governing bodies of the Association.

4. Associate Members have the right to:

4.1. participate in the work of all Association events with the right of an advisory vote;

4.2. make proposals on issues related to the Association's activities;

4.3. represent their own interests in the Association;

4.4. indicate their affiliation with the Association;

4.5. place information about their organization in the Association's informational materials.

5. Associate Members are obliged to:

5.1. comply with the Charter (Statute) of the Association and this Regulation;

5.2. implement the decisions of the Conference;

5.3. actively contribute, within their competence, to achieving the goals and objectives of the Association;

5.4. pay entrance and membership fees in a timely and regular manner;

5.5. not disclose confidential information regarding the Association's activities.

6. For Associate Members of the Association, an entrance fee of 5,000.00 (five thousand) US dollars is established. This fee must be paid within one month after the decision to admit them as an Associate Member of the Association. If the membership fee is not paid within the specified period, the decision on admission as an Associate Member becomes invalid.

7. The payment of the annual membership fee by Associate Members of the Association is made in the amount of 4,000.00 (four thousand) US dollars within the time limit established by the Association's regulatory documents.

8. An Associate Member may withdraw from the Association at their own discretion by submitting a corresponding written application.

9. Grounds for exclusion from the list of the Associate Members are:


9.1. failure to comply with the requirements of the Charter (Statute) and this Regulation;

9.2. irregular payment of membership fees;

9.3. liquidation (bankruptcy) of the Associate Member.

10. The decision on exclusion (withdrawal) from the membership of the Association's Associate Members is made by the Executive Directorate of the Association.
