REGULATIONS

IV World Championship among the national men's youth teams and II World Championship among the national women's youth teams in Fire and Rescue Sport «Grodno-2015»

1. Goals and objectives of the competition

IV World Championship among the national men's youth teams and II World Championship among the national women's youth teams in Fire and Rescue Sport (further – Competitions) are aimed at:

- further development and popularization of the profession of firefighters and rescuers among youth;
- improvement of professional and sportsmanship of youth teams;
- strengthening friendly relations and cooperation between in fire and rescue services of the foreign countries;
- popularization and development of the Fire and Rescue sport among women's teams and their participation in the international events.

2. Organization of the competitions

The International Sport Federation of Firefighters and Rescuers performs general management and organization of the competitions in cooperation with the Central Sports Club of EMERCOM of the Russian Federation.

The Ministry of Emergency Situations of the Republic of Belarus, the Public Association "Belarusian Federation of Fire and Rescue Sport" carry out the direct organization and holding of the competitions (preparation of the competition places, transfer of the participants from the airport to the hotel and back, medical service, provision of the sports and technical equipment, catering services and accommodation, cultural program, publicity in the mass media, etc.).

The competitions are held in accordance with the Rules of the competitions on Fire and Rescue Sport and the Regulations of the international competitions on Fire and Rescue Sport of 2015, approved by the XV International Conference of the International Sport Federation of Firefighters and Rescuers.

The fire and technical equipment (with photo), which apply in combat deployment and fire relay race, should be published on the website www.interfiresport.com, www.mchs.gov.by no later than **July 2, 2015**.

The competitions are held in the combat deployment of the motor pumps of the company «ROSENBAUER FOX III» with connecting hoses STORZ.

3. Timelines and venue of the competitions

The competitions will take place **from 2 to 9 August 2015**.

The venue of the competitions: **Grodno (the Republic of Belarus)**.

4. Participants and conditions of admission

The national men and women's teams of the member-countries of the International Sport Federation of Firefighters and Rescuers, as well as countries received an invitation, take part in the competitions.

The composition of sports delegation, 31 persons: head of delegation – 1, representative of team – 1, coach – 4, doctor – 1, judge – 2, press – 2, athletes: men – 10, women – 10.

It is allowed to change in the quantitative structure of delegation taking into account the declared athletes and the sports personnel.

The representatives of teams should submit to credentials committee the signed request and passport of athletes (or identity card). The athletes are not allowed for competitions without these documents. The requests should be separate for men and women.

The doping control will carry out during the competition. The doping control will carry out in accordance with the provisions of the World Anti-Doping Code (WADC), International testing standards and Prohibited list. The order of collecting samples is determined at the joint meeting of team's representatives and the Main judge panel on **August 3, 2015**.

5. Program of the competition

- August 2** – Arrival of teams
- August 3** – Credentials Committee
– Meeting of team representatives and the Main Jury
– Competition draw
– Testing of sports equipment
- August 4** – Testing of sports equipment
- August 5** – Climbing on an assault ladder
– Opening ceremony
– Semifinals and finals races in climbing on an assault ladder
Rewarding
- August 6** – Overcoming the 100-meter obstacles
– Semifinals and finals races in overcoming the 100-meter obstacles
- August 7** – Fire relay race 4x100 meters
- August 8** – Combat deployment
– Closing ceremony
– Rewarding*
- August 9** – Departure of teams

** The awarding ceremony of winners can be carried out during of the competitions or on the closing day of the competition.*

6. Line-up team and off-set on sports disciplines

Competitions in climbing on an assault ladder, overcoming the 100-meter obstacles, combat deployment carried out on two attempts.

7. Procedure and conditions of defining team and individual championships

Overall team championship is determined on the basis of the least amount of places, taken by teams in all the sports events. In case of equality in total places, the higher place is awarded to the team having best result in the combat deployment.

Team championship in the sports events is determined on the basis of minimum total time. In case of time equality, the teams are awarded the same place (subsequent place is not awarded).

The team, which has not total number of scores, is awarded a place after the teams having full score. In case of equality of incomplete scores, the team is awarded a place to the team having the minimum score time.

Individual championship in sports events, and also championship in fire relay race and combat deployment for boys and girls, is determined according to the best result from two attempts. In case of results equality – according to the best total time of two attempts, and in case of equality amounts of time two attempts – according to the best result of the first attempt, further – athletes who started earlier.

In case of equality results in fire relay race 4x100 meters the higher place is awarded to the team, which started earlier.

Double event do not include in team result.

Finals and semifinals for men and finals for women are held in fire relay race 4x100 meters and climbing on an assault ladder to determine winners. The amount of athletes in final and semifinal races is determined by the number of racetracks. The results of final and semifinal races do not include in team result.

Semifinal races are formed by the results of preliminary races as follows: 1st semifinal race – 5, 1, 4 and 8 results; 2nd semifinal race – 6, 2, 3 and 7. Final race is formed by the results of semifinal races as follows: 3, 1, 2 and 4.

Team and individual championship among men and women in sports disciplines is performed separately.

8. Awarding

The teams, which occupy 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places, are awarded with cups and certificates; and participants – with medals and gifts.

The teams, which occupy 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places in fire relay race 4x100 meters and combat deployment, are awarded with cups and certificates; and participants – with medals, certificates and gifts.

The participants, who occupy 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places in individual championship in climbing on an assault ladder, overcoming 100-meter obstacles and double-event, are awarded with medals, certificates and gifts.

The winners in sports disciplines are awarded with champion ribbons.

The coaches of the national teams in all the sports disciplines are awarded with medals, certificates and gifts.

9. Participation conditions of the sports delegations and participants of the competitions

The annual membership fee of \$ 3,300 (three thousand and three hundred US dollars) is transferred to the International Sport Federation of Firefighters and Rescuers before **April 1, 2015**.

The participation fee of \$ 150 (one hundred and fifty US dollars) for one member of the sports delegation is transferred to the account of the host country **before the competition**.

The expenses, related to business trip of the sports delegations (travel tickets, accommodation, food, daily allowances during travel, salary preservation, etc.), are to be borne by the countries, sending delegation to the competitions.

The expenses, related to organization and conduction of competitions are the organizer's responsibility on account of own and involved means in accordance with the legislation.

10. Procedure and timelines for submission

Preliminary application (official letter) on participation and quantitative composition of sports delegation should be sent **before June 2, 2015**.

Application form for participation of team in the competitions in sports disciplines must be provided to the credentials committee in the day of drawing lots **August 3, 2015** (Application 1).

The standard registration form must be provided **20 days before the competitions** (Application 2).

This information will be used by the organizer for a meeting/departure, reservations and hotel accommodation, training of accreditation badges and other issues.
