REGULATIONS

VI World Championship among youth and juniors and II World Championship among girls and juniors in Fire and Rescue Sport "Grodno-2015"

1. Goals and objectives of the competition

VI World Championship among youth and juniors and II World Championship among girls and juniors in Fire and Rescue Sport (further – Competitions) are aimed at:

- further international cooperation, development and popularization of the profession of firefighters and rescuers among children and youth;

- attracting of young people in Fire and Rescue Sport and their participation in the international competitions;

- formation of active life position, professional orientation of the younger generation, strengthening of children's health, teenagers and youth;

- improvement of sportsmanship and physical education of young firefighters and rescuers;

- strengthening friendly relations and exchange of experience in training of young athletes;

- preparation of sports reserve for the national sports teams.

2. Organization of the competitions

The International Sport Federation of Firefighters and Rescuers performs general management and organization of the competitions.

The Ministry of Emergency Situations of the Republic of Belarus, the Public Association "Belarusian Federation of Fire and Rescue Sport" carry out the direct organization and holding of the competitions (preparation of the competition places, transfer of the participants from the airport to the hotel and back, medical service, provision of the sports and technical equipment, catering services and accommodation, cultural program, publicity in the mass media, etc.).

The competitions are held in accordance with the Rules of the competitions on Fire and Rescue Sport and the Regulations of the international competitions on Fire and Rescue Sport of 2015, approved by the XV International Conference of the International Sport Federation of Firefighters and Rescuers.

The fire-technical equipment (with photo), which apply in combat deployment and fire relay race, should be published on the website <u>www.interfiresport.com</u>, www.mchs.gov.by no later than **July 2, 2015.**

The competitions are held in the combat deployment of the motor pumps of the company «ROSENBAUER FOX III» with connecting hoses STORZ.

3. Timelines and venue of the competitions

The competitions will take place from 2 to 9 August 2015. The venue of the competitions: Grodno (the Republic of Belarus).

4. Participants and conditions of admission

The national youth teams of boys and girls of the member-countries of the International Sport Federation of Firefighters and Rescuers, as well as countries received an invitation, take part in the competitions.

The composition of sports delegations, 31 persons: head of delegation -1, representative of team -2, coach (boys, girls) -2, coach-educator -2 (boys, girls), doctor -2, judge -2, press -2;

athletes (boys) – 9 persons: 1997-1998 years of birth – 3 (juniors), 1999-2000 years of birth – 3 (average group), 2001 years of birth and younger – 3 (younger group);

athletes (girls) – 9 persons: 1997-1998 years of birth – 3 (juniors), 1999-2000 years of birth – 3 (average group), 2001 years of birth and younger – 3 (younger group).

It is allowed to change the quantitative structure of delegation taking into account the declared athletes and the sports personnel.

The representatives of teams should submit to credentials committee the signed request and passport (or identity card). The athletes for competitions are not allowed without these documents. The request should be separate for men's team and women's team.

Competitions in climbing on an assault ladder, overcoming the 100-meter obstacles, combat deployment carried out on two attempts.

7. Procedure and conditions of defining team and individual championships

Overall team championship among boys and girls is determined on the basis of the least amount of places, taken by the teams in all the sports events. In case of equality in total places, the higher place is awarded to the team having best result in the combat deployment.

Team championship in the sports events for boys and girls is determined on the basis of minimum total time. In case of time equality, the teams are awarded the same place (subsequent place is not awarded).

The team, which has not total number of scores, is awarded a place after the teams having full score. In case of equality of incomplete scores, the team is awarded a place to the team having the minimum score time.

Individual championship in sports events, and also championship in fire relay race and combat deployment for boys and girls, is determined according to the best result from two attempts. In case of results equality – according to the best total time of two attempts, and in case of equality amounts of time two attempts – according to the best result of the first attempt, further – athletes who started earlier.

Every age group performs the final races to determine winners in climbing on an assault ladder and overcoming 100 meters obstacles. The number of athletes in final races determines according to the number of racetracks. The results of final races do not include in team standings.

The final races are formed by the results of preliminary races under the scheme: 3,1,2,4 result.

Team and individual championship among boys and girls in sports disciplines is performed separately.

8. Awarding

The teams, which occupy 1^{st} , 2^{nd} , and 3^{rd} places, are awarded with cups and certificates; and participants – with medals and gifts.

The teams, which occupy 1^{st} , 2^{nd} , and 3^{rd} places in fire relay race 4x100 meters and combat deployment, are awarded with cups and certificates; and participants – with medals, certificates and gifts.

The participants, who occupy 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places in individual championship in climbing on an assault ladder, overcoming 100-meter obstacles, are awarded with medals, certificates and gifts.

The winners in sports disciplines are awarded with champion ribbons.

The coaches of the national teams in all the sports disciplines are awarded with medals, certificates and gifts.

9. Participation conditions of the sports delegations and participants of the competition

The annual membership fee of \$ 3,300 (three thousand and three hundred US dollars) is transferred to the International Sport Federation of Firefighters and Rescuers **before April 1, 2015**.

The participation fee of \$ 150 (one hundred and fifty US dollars) for one member of the sports delegation is transferred to the account of the host country **before the competition**.

The expenses, related to business trip of the sports delegations (travel tickets, accommodation, food, daily allowances during travel, salary preservation, etc.), are to be borne by the countries, sending delegation to the competitions.

The expenses, related to organization and conduction of competitions are the organizer's responsibility on account of own and involved means in accordance with the legislation.

10. Procedure and timelines for submission

Preliminary application (official letter) on participation and quantitative composition of sports delegation should be sent **before June 2**, 2015.

Application form for participation of team in the competitions in sports disciplines must be provided to the credentials committee in the day of drawing lots **August 3, 2015** (Application 1).

The standard registration form must be provided **20 days before** the competitions (Application 2).

This information will be used by the organizer for a meeting/departure, reservations and hotel accommodation, training of accreditation badges and other issues.
